1	<i>I Harp as I See It</i>	Abranthar "Twoquills" Foraeren discusses the goodly drow that live in the Promenade of the Dark Maiden close to Waterdeep's Skullport, and discusses the drow silver sister, Qilué Veladorn.
2	<i>Siolet's School Of Language: Orcish</i>	Reading and Practicing the Lessons in this book enables the reader to learn the Orcish language with only 125 downtime days. This book is written in Common and disappears after use.
3	<i>The Sharp Eye and Sharper Tongue: Observations of a Learned Sage</i>	Ammathair Hawkfeather, Sage of Waterdeep writes of the events of 1359 DR, with an emphasis on Bahamut regaining his status as a deity after Gareth Dragonsbane plants the Tree-Gem and mortals begin to worship the platinum dragon once more. This book is written in Common.
4	<i>The Black Book of a Garrulous Merchant</i>	Haldimer Hurezan, Factor of the Blingblade Coster of Murann claims that the names written in this tomb were people killed due to the nefarious activities of merchants throughout Faerun. This book is written in Common.
5	<i>Under a Wyrms Wing</i>	Shalindoth Laurgoren, human paladin of Bahamut, describes her life as being raised by a pair of golden dragons and how it contributed to her journey of faith. This book is written in both Common and Draconic.
6	<i>Untitled</i>	This book is blank, but has a giant Owlbear feather as a bookmark.
7	<i>To Harp at Twilight</i>	Storm Silverhand, chosen of Mystra, provides training instructions to Harpers that carry out their missions at night or via covert operations. This book is written in Common.
8	<i>The Oath Of The Bow</i>	This is a scroll of a beautifully illustrated Oathbow with the discussion of it's properties. Reading this gives the PC knowledge of the Oathbow as described in the Dungeon Master's Guide.
9	<i>Orcs In Al-Hadar</i>	This tome is written in Common, but describes the perfect harmony between Orcs and other humanoids in the cities of Zahkharan.
10	<i>A Merchant's Musings</i>	This black leather book by Suzail merchant Holdryn Nalaster discusses trade in the Moonsea region. This book is written in Common.
11	<i>You Can't Take It With You</i>	Hommil Dundreth, Merchant-Mage of Hlinter writes about the suspected location of merchant family riches, including the known custom of concealing one's wealth in the town graveyard, in family crypts for the rich or in cavities in headstones of loved ones for the less well-to-do. This book is written in Common.
12	<i>Tales of Far Travels</i>	Seroun of Calimport talks if adventures in continents that have since lost touch with Faerun: Maztica and Kara-Tur. This book is written in Common.
13	<i>Great Changes Aborning (ballad performed c 1332)</i>	Mintiper Moonsilver the bard composes of ballad that accurately predicts the birth of Midnight, who would eventually take the helm of the goddess of magic, Mystra. The lyrics are written in Common and provides tablature for the lute and dulcimer.

14	<i>Decent Into Twilight</i>	This purple leather book discusses the various glowing lichen that can be found throughout the Underdark, including those that are edible or poisonous. This book is written in Common.
15	<i>Siolet's School Of Language: Netherese</i>	Reading and Practicing the Lessons in this book requires the reader to learn the Netherese language with only 125 downtime days. This book is written in Draconic.
16	<i>Yuan-ti Truths</i>	Reading this book provides all the lore and information about Yuan-ti Purebloods as found in Volo's Guide to Monsters. This book is written in Common.
17	<i>A Merchant's Sagacity</i>	Blackthorn Belgadar takes time to tell of how understanding the lore and history related to a particular good or region is good for profits. This book is written in Common.
18	<i>A Shorter History of Amn</i>	This anonymously written book unfavorably describes the wealthy nation's oligarchy system of government, the Council of Five. This book is written in Common.
19	<i>The Tome Of Clear Thought</i>	This is a scroll of a beautifully illustrated Tome Of Clear Thought with the discussion of its properties. Reading this gives the PC knowledge of the Tome Of Clear Thought as described in the Dungeon Master's Guide.
20	<i>Arglauth's Guide to the North</i>	Arglauth Melroryrr, Sage of Mulmaster provides information about the human kingdom of Hartsvale, and speculates on the remaining ancient giant tribes that still make the Endless Ice Sea. This book is written in Common.
21	<i>A Trader from Telflamm: My Years Amid High-Heaped Gold</i>	Uldurn Maskovert describes the large profits that he made as being a merchant in Telflamm, a city that acted as a way station for trading between Faerun and Kara-Tur via a path known as the Golden Road. This book is written in Common.
22	<i>Falcon Fun</i>	Edwin Narlok of Waterdeep provides instructions on how to breed, raise and train falcons as pets and familiars (use Hawk stats). This book is written in Common.
23	<i>To Harp and to Help</i>	Alustriel, High Lady of Silverymoon provides the locations to secret Harper safe houses that prevail throughout the sword coast. The locations show as glowing text to the reader in between the lines of the book (which is poetry) to someone who is a member of the Harper faction. This book is written in Common.
24	<i>Of Time Past and Forward</i>	This leather bound book is a copy of the story of Sunbright Steelshanks, an ancient barbarian from the time of the Netherese Empire. This book is written in Common.
25	<i>Dahg The Culinary Bounty Hunter</i>	This small chapbook discusses Dahg, a chef who took up bounty hunting, but made more famous due to his use of cooking utensils as improvised weapons. This book is written in Common.
26	<i>Observations Of Unicorns</i>	Reading this book gives the reader the knowledge of all Lore (no stats or mechanics) of the Unicorn as described in the Monster Manual. This book is written in Common.

27	<i>Of Northern Tribes</i>	Reading this book gives the reader the knowledge of all of the totems and their effects as per the Path Of The Totem Warrior Barbarian Primal Path as described in the Player's Handbook. This book is written in Common.
28	<i>Collectable Figurines</i>	Reading this book gives the reader the knowledge of all of the Figurines of Wondrous Power as described in the Dungeon Masters' Handbook.
29	<i>Lost Amongst Pirates</i>	Geonos of Crimmor laments of all the caravan shipments that have been lost to pirates in the moon sea and the sword coast. This book is written in Common.
30	<i>Chosen</i>	This black leather book has stars painted on it and glitter that rubs off on the readers hand when they pick up the book. This book discusses whom the anonymous author thinks of a chosen of a particular god in the Faerunian Pantheon. This book is written in Common.
31	<i>Siolet's School Of Language: Drow Sign Language</i>	Reading and Practicing the Lessons in this book enables the reader to learn the Drow Sign Language with only 125 downtime days. This book is written in Common.
32	<i>Untitled</i>	This false book opens up, and reveals that a small blue egg (the size of a chicken's egg) nestled in the middle of the book where the pages have been cut away to nestle the egg.
33	<i>Untitled</i>	This false book opens up, with a winged snake that flies into the open air out of fear.
34	<i>Cauldron Bright: Fireside Tales of Old Tethyr</i>	This book captures the tales of times when merchants braved the dangers of the Omlarandin Mountains for mining omlar gems. These gems are exceptionally useful in the arcane arts and often command large amounts of gold. This book is written in Common.
35	<i>Ballads and Lore of One Dusty Road Vol I</i>	Sharanralee Crownstar talks about her life as a Harper and the adventures that she has seen over the last ten years. This book is written in Common and dated as of 1350 DR.
36	<i>Ballads and Lore of One Dusty Road Vol II</i>	Sharanralee Crownstar talks about her life as a Harper and the adventures that she has seen over the last ten years. A passive perception check of 17 reveals a silver harper pin stuffed into the binding. This book is written in Common and dated as of 1350 DR.
37	<i>A Ranger's Road</i>	Thaulavvan Tridentstar discusses his choice to become a ranger and live amongst the elves in the forests of Cormyr. This book is written in Common.
38	<i>The Archmage's Robe</i>	This is a scroll of a beautifully illustrated Robe Of The Arch Mage with the discussion of it's properties. Reading this gives the PC knowledge of the Robe Of The Arch Mage as described in the Dungeon Master's Guide.
39	<i>Of Trap Doors</i>	This book provides instructions on how to create trapped doors. This book is written in Gnomish.
40	<i>The People Of Chult</i>	This ledger acts as a list of contacts that Blue Flower merchant company keeps in contact with in Chult for the variety of services they use when going on trade excursions throughout the region.

41	<i>Sayings of a Wise and Fat Merchant Vol I</i>	Guldom Tchar of Mirabar discusses his good fortune as a miner and merchant, providing insight into the precious metals of the region and how their market values changes over time. This book is written in Dwarfish.
42	<i>Sayings of a Wise and Fat Merchant Vol II</i>	Guldom Tchar of Mirabar discusses his good fortune as a miner and merchant, and provides insight into negotiation strategies with neighbors of the region such as Luskan and Mithril Hall. This book is written in Dwarfish.
43	<i>Greenwillow's Insight</i>	This green leather tome is written by the half elf, Greenwillow. Greenwillow discusses the need for elves to keep peace with goodly humanoid races that may unintentionally pass into their territory. This book is written in Elvish.
44	<i>Wanderings with Quill and Sword</i>	Dated as of 1349 DR, Mirt the Moneylender discusses the horrors he saw when he was an adventurer in the halls of Undermountain. Mirt goes on to discuss the construction of his mansion near Mount Waterdeep with the wealth he plundered from there. This book is written in Common.
45	<i>To Tournament</i>	This book provides directions on how to plan, promote and execute a jousting tournament. This book is written in Common.
46	<i>Home in the Hallows At Last: Musings of a Retired Wanderer</i>	Uldon Saertluth of Turmish reflects on his 30 years of wandering Toril. This book is written in Common.
47	<i>Ramblings</i>	This book of random babblings from Nenemith the Sage is nothing special, but a successful Arcana check at DC 13 will reveal treasure map that leads to an ancient cache of Belgoran Brandy, made famous by the Cormyr noble family of the same name. This book is written in Common.
48	<i>Siolet's School Of Language: Infernal</i>	Reading and Practicing the Lessons in this book enables the reader to learn the Infernal language with only 125 downtime days. This book is written in Common.
49	<i>Tall Tales: A Ranger's Life</i>	Amhritar the Tall writes of his encounters with deities during his life as a ranger, including the time he had tea with Mielikki, the swim that he had with Eadro, and the supper he shared with Silvanus. This book is written in Common.
50	<i>Quiet Days along the Dessarin</i>	Leaontar Dlarvin, Bargemaster of "the Black Boat" describes starting his trip from the Dancing Falls at the base of the Lost Peaks to the Sea of Swords just south of Waterdeep. This book is written in Common.
51	<i>I Am Reminded: Memoirs of a Dragonslayer Vol I</i>	Aernstag Oeblym of Starmantle reflects on his career as a dragon slayer around 1350 DR, and discusses the various evil chromatic dragons he's slayed over the last 20 years. This book is written in Common.

52	<i>I Am Reminded: Memoirs of a Dragonslayer Vol II</i>	Aernstag Oeblym of Starmantle reflects on his career as a dragon slayer around 1350 DR, and discusses how he is getting his daughter Varyanya primed to take up the family business. This book is written in Common.
53	<i>Klauth's Curio</i>	While this book is written Anonymously, an Insight Check against a DC 13 shows that this story was written by Klauth The Red Dragon and provides the details on how he procures an Air Ship. This book is written in Draconic.
54	<i>Gnomish Toys</i>	This book has a false bottom and contains the instructions and materials to create a small clock work device that follows the Tinker rules for the gnome racial ability in the Players Handbook. This book is written in Common.
55	<i>Siolet's School Of Language: Celestial</i>	Reading and Practicing the Lessons in this book enables the reader to learn the Celestial language with only 125 downtime days. This book is written in Common.
56	<i>The Moonshae Chronicles Vol I</i>	An anonymous author writes about Flamsterd, a small island west of Gwynneth, and its large population of wizards and other magic users. This book is written in Common circa 1340 DR.
57	<i>The Moonshae Chronicles Vol II</i>	An anonymous author writes about the large island of Gwynneth, and its large population of elves, mermen, and folk. This book is written in Common circa 1340 DR.
58	<i>The Moonshae Chronicles Vol III</i>	An anonymous author writes about the large island of Gwynneth, but focuses on Myrloch Vale: home to the largest known population of fairie dragons in Faerun. This book is written in Common circa 1340 DR.
59	<i>A Sage's Travel Guide to the North</i>	This white leather tome by Zanshareen Sabiyrn provides details about traveling to the northern part of the Sword Coast, when an emphasis on Ten Towns. This book is written in Common.
60	<i>Tailoring For Giants</i>	This book teaches tailors that are medium sized creatures or smaller how to measure, calculate materials estimates, and assemble clothing for giants. This book is written in Common.
61	<i>Solar Spectacles</i>	This gnomish book provides directions on how to craft dark lens glasses that allow those that are sensitive to the light to walk the surface. This book is written in Gnomish.
62	<i>Siolet's School Of Language: Undercommon</i>	Reading and Practicing the Lessons in this book enables the reader to learn the Undercommon language with only 125 downtime days. This book is written in Common.
63	<i>Legacy of the Three Shields</i>	Iana Robinsong of Silverymoon writes of a 500 year old legend of the three shields of Silverymoon: Earth, Forest, and Sky. This book is written in Elvish.
64	<i>Words on a Wave Vol I</i>	Arthaeuil Nrensam, High Trident of Onthalasp discusses his fealty to Umberlee and the temple dedicated to her worship on the Isle of Onthalasp. This book is written in Aquan.
65	<i>Words on a Wave Vol II</i>	Arthaeuil Nrensam, High Trident of Onthalasp discusses his fealty to Umberlee and the unknown source of her ire for the priest and the island of Onthalasp. This book is written in Aquan.

66	<i>The Magi's Staff</i>	This is a scroll of a beautifully illustrated Staff Of The Magi with the discussion of it's properties. Reading this gives the PC knowledge of the Staff Of The Magi as described in the Dungeon Master's Guide.
67	<i>Tidings of Taldan</i>	This is a copy of a work from 778 DR. This book contains tablature for music that was popular amongst the wandering bards of the time. The tablature magically adjusts for the instrument that the reader is proficient in. This book is written in Common.
68	<i>A Harper's Guide</i>	Alustriel, High Lady Of Silverymoon writes about Harper activities on the Sword Coast and factions that Harper's should keep a close watch on. This book is written in Common.
69	<i>Healing Salves</i>	This is a false book that contains a small, thin jar that contains doses of Keoghtom's Ointment.
70	<i>A Merchant's Tale</i>	This is mysterious clockwork book that when each of its ten dials are fully wound, audibly recites a chapter from Jarn Tiir of Lantan's autobiography. The voice tells the story in Common.
71	<i>Life Beneath the Sails Vol I</i>	An anonymous author discusses their life as a pirate. In this first volume, the author discusses their abusive home life and their decision to sign up with the crew of a pirate vessel in the Sea of Stars.
72	<i>Life Beneath the Sails Vol II</i>	An anonymous author discusses their life as a pirate. In this second volume, the author discusses their life as a quartermaster and eventual promotion to first mate of a successful pirate ship in the Sea of Stars. This book is written in Common
73	<i>Life Beneath the Sails Vol III</i>	An anonymous author discusses their life as a pirate. In this third and final volume, the author discusses their ascension to Captain of a successful pirate ship in the Sea of Stars and their subsequent quiet retirement. This book is written in Common
74	<i>Tips and Tricks For Surface Dwelling</i>	Reading this magical book (once use) gives a Drow, Svirkneblin or Duergar on their first deception check when trying to pass themselves off as their surface dwelling equivalent. This book is written in Undercommon.
75	<i>Rothe, Rothe, Rothe Your Boat</i>	This book is bound in a wooly material and discusses how Rothe can be raised for cloth, meat, and cheese. This book is written in Common.
76	<i>A Wayfarer's Belt-Book of Advice</i>	Rasthiavar of Iriaebor, Sage gives the reader terminology used by locals of the Cormyr when traveling throughout that region. This book is written in Common.
77	<i>Translations from Kara-Tur Haiku Vol I</i>	Lhaeo of Shadowdale, translates Kara-Tur haikus that are written around the subject of love. This book is written in Shou and Common and dated as of 1354 DR.
78	<i>Translations from Kara-Tur Haiku Vol II</i>	Lhaeo of Shadowdale, translates Kara-Tur haikus that are written around the subject of war. This book is written in Shou and Common and dated as of 1354 DR.

79	<i>Translations from Kara-Tur Haiku Vol III</i>	Lhaeo of Shadowdale, translates Kara-Tur haikus that are written around the subject of tranquility. This book is written in Shou and Common and dated as of 1354 DR.
80	<i>Thoughts Found Upon a Forested Path and an Adventure or Two Found There As Well</i>	Legendary Adventurer and Hedgewizard Bowgentle discusses the adventuring that he has had in the forested regions of Cormanthor, and his plans to spend the twilight of his days there with the elves. This book is written in Common.
81	<i>Unearthed Barcana</i>	This book describes the various types of liquor and sprits that are made by the races native to the Underdark. This book is written in Common.
82	<i>The Complete Dragon Hunter</i>	Smerdiuk Dragonbane of Arabel It outlines his methodology for searching out, hunting down, and defeating a dragon in combat. It also gives specifics on how one could dress its carcass, harvest it for practical use, and properly dispose of any remains in ways that prevent resurrection or undeath. This book is written in Common.
83	<i>The Falling Feather: Romance and Passion among Modern Noble Lasses</i>	This tome is bound in pink leather and provides a number of fictional (?) dalliances between noble women and men of "low birth". This book is written in Common.
84	<i>Encyclopedia Serōsica Vol I</i>	An anonymous writer provides basic descriptions of Seros, of the undersea realm of the merfolk who live in The Sea Of Fallen Stars. This book is written in Common.
85	<i>Encyclopedia Serōsica Vol II</i>	An anonymous writer provides basic descriptions of Seros, of the undersea realm of the merfolk who live in The Sea Of Fallen Stars, but also discusses the activity and occupants of the Pirate Isles. This book is written in Common.
86	<i>Untitled</i>	This book is blank, but is full of pages that disappear in a puff of smoke when the smallest spark or flame makes contact with it.
87	<i>Sayings of a Wyrn</i>	The author of this book, Naurglaur the Green Dragon, supplies a number of inculpatory pronouncements when encountering a foul order, such as "They who smelt it, dealt it", "They who deduced it, produced it", and "Who ever spoke it, broke it". This book is written in draconic.
88	<i>Of Living Steel</i>	This metal box contains notes about sightings of various men and women made completely of metal. This book is written in Common.
89	<i>The Book of the Coast</i>	Mespert of Baldur's Gate provides a list of various shops and restaurants that a merchant may engage in commerce with . This book is written in Common.
90	<i>Of Jackals</i>	This book discusses the Jackal wizard: a class of wizard that cannot learn spells on their own, but simply steal spells from other magic users that have them memorized. This book is written in Common.

91	<i>Talk of the Taverns</i>	Tasagar Winterwind, Scribe to the Guilds of Selgaunt collects the most popular rumors collected from taverns across the Realms. This book is written in Common.
92	<i>My Life with an Adventurer Vol I</i>	Kylae Aglundar discusses what is like to have a partner whose career is adventuring, including the ups and downs. This book is a copy, as this book was originally written in 1238 DR. This book is written in Common.
93	<i>My Life with an Adventurer Vol II</i>	Kylae Aglundar discusses what is like to have a partner whose career is adventuring, and discusses her decision to ultimately take up the career herself. This book is an original in very good shape written in 1238 DR. This book is written in Common.
94	<i>Hunter's Blessing</i>	Solonor Thelandira, the elven god of hunting, sung this song outside the gates of Myth Drannor when the hunt commenced to find game for it's first celebration feast. The anonymous priest of this god wrote the lyrics, but there is no music set to it. This is written in Elfish.
95	<i>Gold Amid Dragonfire</i>	Donstan of Athkatla, Master Adventurer discusses how he chose to leave his family of merchants for the adventuring life, only to become more wealthy over years of adventuring than most of his family combined. This book is written in Common.
96	<i>Siolet's School Of Language: Shou</i>	Reading and Practicing the Lessons in this book enables the reader to learn the Shou language with only 125 downtime days. This book is written in Common.
97	<i>Adventures of Camber Fosrick</i>	This large book contains the six smaller stories that have been written about Camber Fosrick, a fictional 'consulting cogitator' (detective) who's character was popular with young readers. This book is written in Common.
98	<i>The Strings of a Shattered Lyre</i>	Tammarast Tengloves, Bard of Elupar writes of his adventures in the Deepwing Mountains, which were populate by a high number of flying monsters including: manticores, griffons and hippogriffs, red dragons, and wyverns. This book is written in Common.
99	<i>A Merchant Master's Life</i>	Asargrym of Baldur's Gate provides insight into what it takes to go from relative squalor to becoming a wealthy merchant. This book is written in Common.
